You are always welcome at Park Central Toastmasters. As a club, we are open to anyone in the community. Park Central is a wonderful, supportive place to improve speaking, listening, and leadership skills. The abilities learned here have helped people communicate effectively in all types of interpersonal situations.

Meeting Time and Place: Park Central meets from 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. every Tuesday at the YWCA, 755 East Willetta, Phoenix, AZ (just southeast of 7th Street and McDowell). Directions are on the website.

If You Decide to Join: To join, complete and submit a membership application to the Vice President of Membership or Treasurer for new member fees of \$20 plus pro-rated membership dues. To gain an understanding of the responsibilities of membership and the typical functioning of a meeting, please consult our Club Manual, which is posted on our website; or contact the Vice President of Membership for a hard copy. Toastmasters International (TI) sends you a new member kit and a Communications and Leadership Program brochure that you will use to hone your skills.

Financial Commitment: The dues are \$10 a month for full-time students, and \$15 a month for all other members. You pay dues at the first of each month to maintain membership, and can provide money in advance for more than one month's dues. Park Central Toastmasters dues cover international dues; the bagels, pastries and coffee provided at meetings; YWCA room rental; website maintenance; newsletter production; and miscellaneous expenses.

Once You Become a Member: As with many endeavors, the more you participate in the club, the more benefit you derive.

So, you have the most to gain from regular attendance. As a member, you will periodically be assigned a function to perform at meetings, such as greeter, ballot counter, and clock watcher. Our weekly Citation newsletter, which is posted on our website, lists who is responsible for each function for the next four weeks. Responsibilities for each function are described in the Club Manual. As a new member, you will also be provided an experienced Park Central member as a mentor to assist you in your roles and responsibilities.

Members are expected to fulfill the functions that they are assigned at each meeting. If, you are unable to perform your function, it is your responsibility to find a replacement and to contact the Toastmaster with the name of the replacement.
